Student's Responsibility:

- Research Schools.

- Listen to your parents. We expect that your family will have open conversations about your respective likes, dislikes, and needs in picking a school.
- Don't gossip!
- Complete applications.
- Talk to Ms. Spengler at any time and keep her informed about how the process is working for you.
- Adhere to all deadlines and guidelines.

Parent's Responsibility:

- Research schools.
- Help your daughter maintain the visit and open house calendar as well as arrange shadow visits.
- Keep an open mind!
