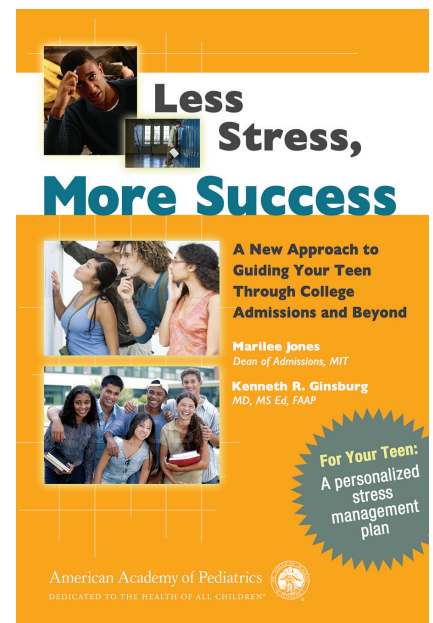
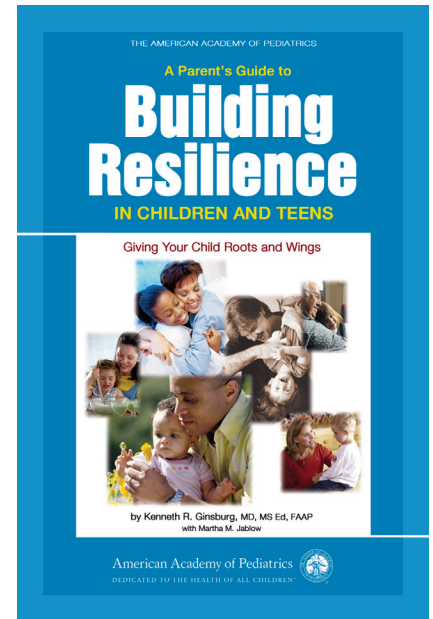

He creates strategies to raise resilient children who are capable of dealing with life's difficulties and who learn from personal defeat.
